

Adjectives

Adjectives describe nouns.

They make your writing more powerful because the reader has a more vivid mental picture

Example The broken, haunted house sat on the peak of the high hill.



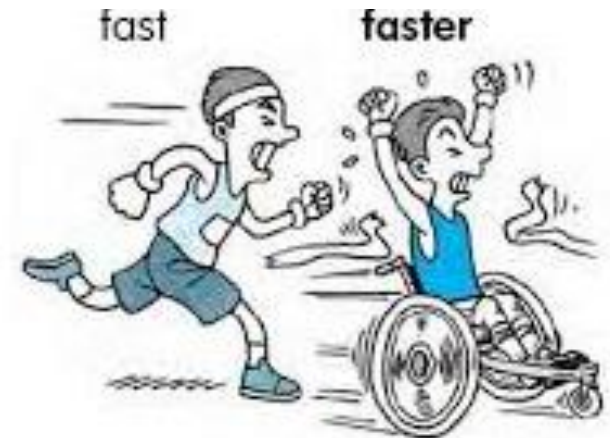
Comparative Nouns compare 2 nouns

Eg bigger, smaller, taller

They usually end in **-er**

(unless it has 2 syllables – then you use ‘more’ in front

Eg Joe’s 11+ score was more impressive than Max)



Superlative Adjectives used to show how one noun is different from all the others

Eg biggest, smallest, tallest

They usually end in **-est**

(unless it has 2 syllables – then you use ‘most’ in front

Eg Joe’s 11+ score was most impressive)
