

Articles, Connectives and Prepositions



Article is a small word that comes before a noun.

There are 2 types of articles:

- Indefinite – **a** or **an** (used if the noun begins with a vowel)

I ate an apple.

- Definite – **the**

I ate the apple.



Connective is a word that connects words, phrases, clauses and sentences.

Some examples of connectives are: for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so (FANBOYS)

Eg: Let's go lunch after shopping.



Prepositions are words that show the relationship of one noun or pronoun with another noun or pronoun.

The cat is under the table
