Analogy

- 1) b (inside shape shaded diagonally and duplicated upside down on top)
- 2) d (inside shapes duplicated but top half cut off)
- 3) c (shape on right placed inside and shaded shape on left has left half completed)

Codes

- 1) e (L square, 3 lines)
- 2) e (L bottom Square, S top triangle)
- 3) b (M - lines in middle, Z 3 lines)

Series

- 1) a (Single L rotates round clockwise and reflects Double L rotates round clockwise and rotates)
- 2) a (inside shading rotates clockwise, outside shading rotates clockwise)
- 3) c (Inside arrow alternates large then small & rotates anti clockwise, 2 outside arrows alternates small then large and rotates anti clockwise)

Odd One Out

- 1) e (Inside arrow anti clock wise)
- 2) c (white on top)
- 3) d (x and black dot not on same side)

Matrices

- 1) c (Horizontal outline shading swap, bottom shape is marble shading small shape enlarges)
- 2) a (vertical, left bumps point down, followed by right bumps)
- 3) d (horizontal, large and shading stripe on the right)
