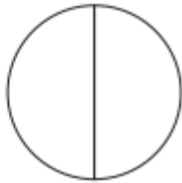

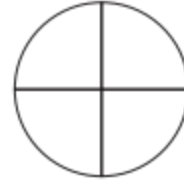
Shade in 50% of these shapes
