

Subject in Sentences



Subjects in sentences are 'who' or 'what' the sentence is about.

They are usually nouns or pronouns.

To spot the subject in sentence identify who or what is doing the verb.

Example :

The mouse ate the cheese

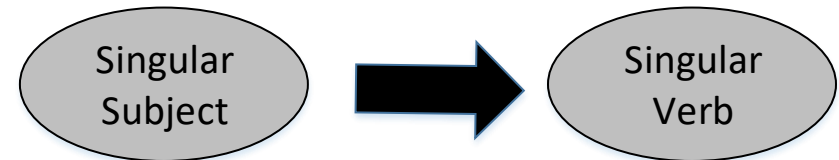


Subject-verb agreement

All sentences must have a verb.

The **subject and verb must match:**

- If the *subject is singular* then the *verb is also singular*
- If the *subject is plural* then *verb is also plural*



The **boy walked** to school.



The **children walk** to school.
