"Yes," he said. "Go get ready".

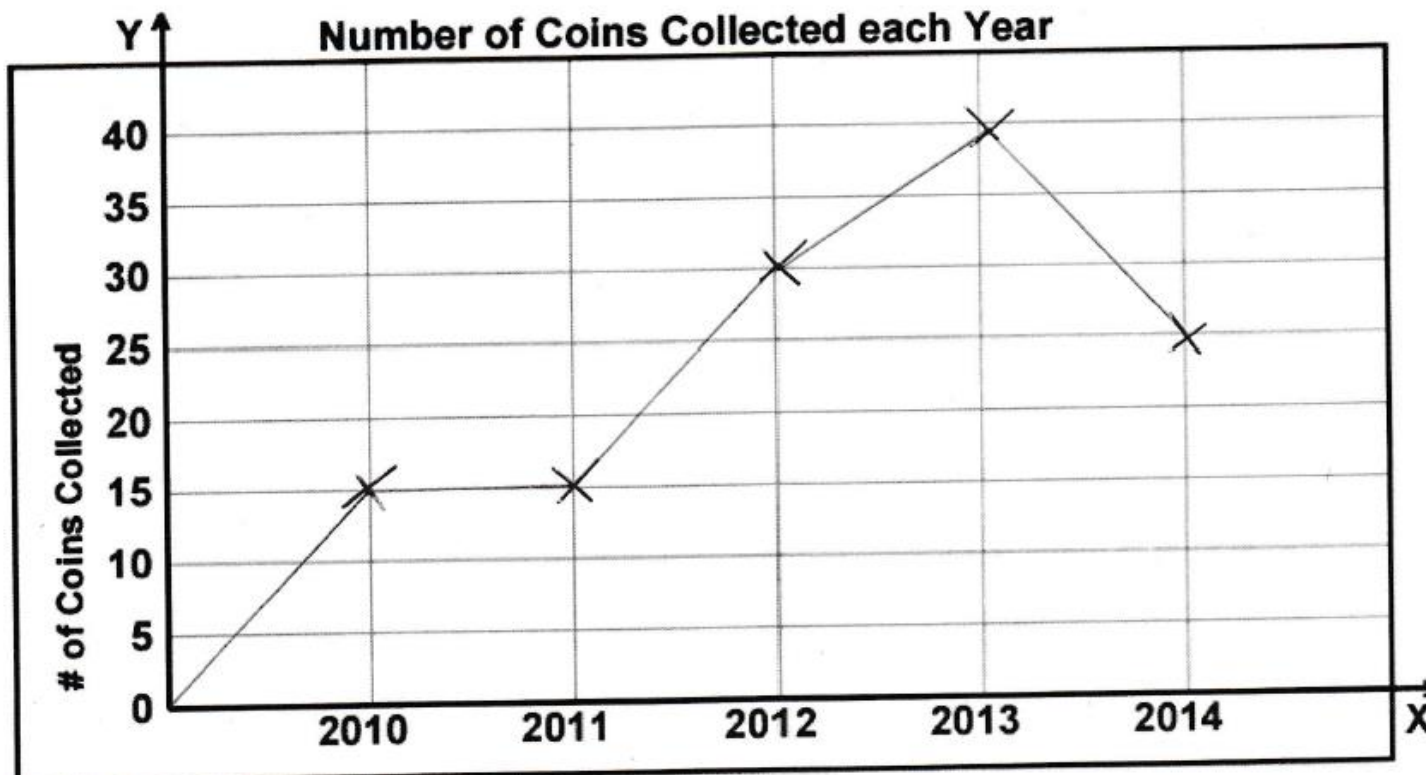

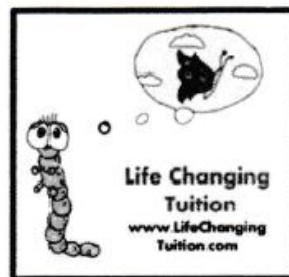

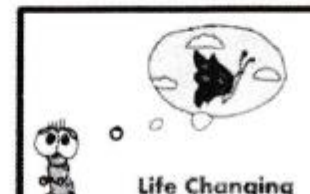
