'whoever' makes the most sense in this sentence because it is not referring to a specific person, but to one of many people.

'beneath' should be spelled 'beneath'.

'devise' should be 'device' — 'devise' is a verb, whereas 'device' is a noun.

'access' should be 'access' — the word is spelled with two 'c's.

12. N

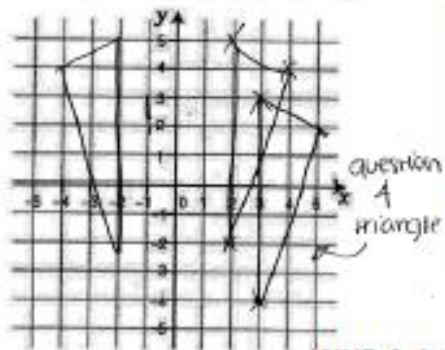
There are no mistakes in this line.

- E** - The arrow head is pointing away from the white square. The wide end of the trapezium is closest to the square.
- D** - The arrow is curving up towards the base of the triangle. The circular face of the cylinder is pointing towards the side of the triangle. (A cylinder is a 3-D tube, with parallel sides and circular ends.)

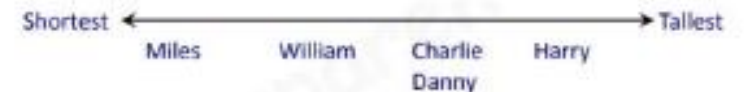
