#### NVR (odd One Out)

- 1) d (no right angles)

#### NVR Similarities

- 1) **A**  
All figures must have a white semicircle.
- 2) **E**  
In all figures, there is a black square inside a white triangle.
- 3) **A**  
In each series square, the rocket rotates 45 degrees clockwise. The colour of the circle alternates between white and black.
- 4) **B**  
In each series square, the circle moves down in the order: top, middle, bottom, top, middle. The black ellipse changes size in the order: small, medium-sized, big, small, medium-sized.
- 5) **C**  
In each series square, the black shading moves up one shape.
